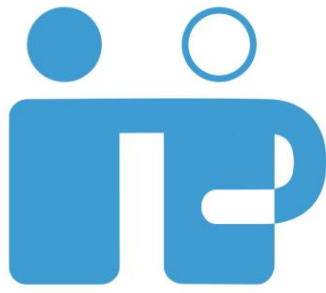

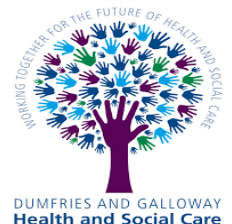

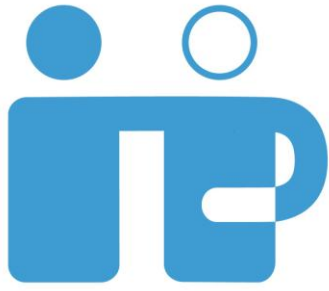

How can a buddy help?

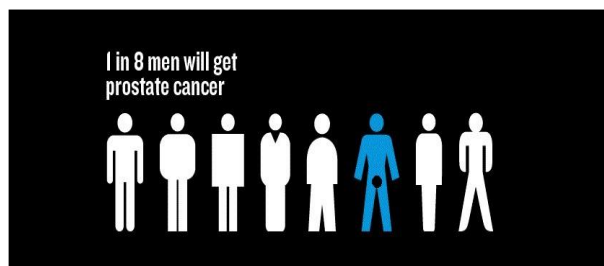
